A three day (24 hour) training program designed for female law enforcement officers or supervisors currently assigned to a plain clothes assignment in Criminal Investigations, Narcotics, Gangs or Vice or who work the street and may be called upon for Temporary Duty assignments where they would be required to function in other than a traditional Police function.

Through the course of this three day specialized training program attendees will be brought up to date on current criminal investigative techniques and new ways to apply them. This course “cross trains” attendees to work in a variety of different criminal investigative functions including general crimes, financial crimes, narcotics, vice or gangs. The course is also well suited for female officers and supervisors who aspire to transfer into investigative units.

In addition to the investigative facet of the training the court preparation and testimony section provides great information for attendees without a great deal of court experience and still gives helpful tips to experienced investigators.

Working in a plain clothes assignment presents new challenges and can be very stressful to an officer. Coupled with the day to day stress incurred in life it can sometimes become physically and emotionally draining. Stress management techniques will be given to attendees so that they can deal with what happens to them both on and off the job.

The instructors for this conference have many years of Criminal Investigative experience and have a wealth of information to share with attendees of this program. This is truly a unique program as it cross trains officers in a variety of different types of investigations and investigative techniques as well as helping in the transition from uniform officer to plain clothes.
